Good Intercepts At Falcon

Reverse circulation drilling of Wedgetail Exploration NL's Falcon Prospect has generated a series of strong intercepts that are comparable to those along the high-grade mineralised reefs within the proposed Golden Gate open pits.



The reefs are located two kilometres to the east-southeast of Falcon. The company's RC drilling has confirmed the results its RAB drilling conducted in late 2005 which showed that high-grade mineralisation extends over a strike length of 600 metres, from surface to a depth of more than 40 metres.

Highlights from the RC drilling of the Falcon Prospect include: 9 m @ 4.1 g/t Au from 58 m in FARC0003, 14 m @ 3.11 g/t Au from 6 m in FARC0004, 4 m @ 18.1 g/t Au from 42 m in FARC0005, 4 m @ 14.4 g/t Au from 2 m in FARC0008.

The gold mineralisation intersected by the RC drill holes remains open along strike and at depth, and Wedgetail have scheduled further RC drilling for the coming months.
